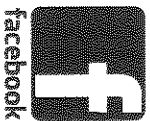

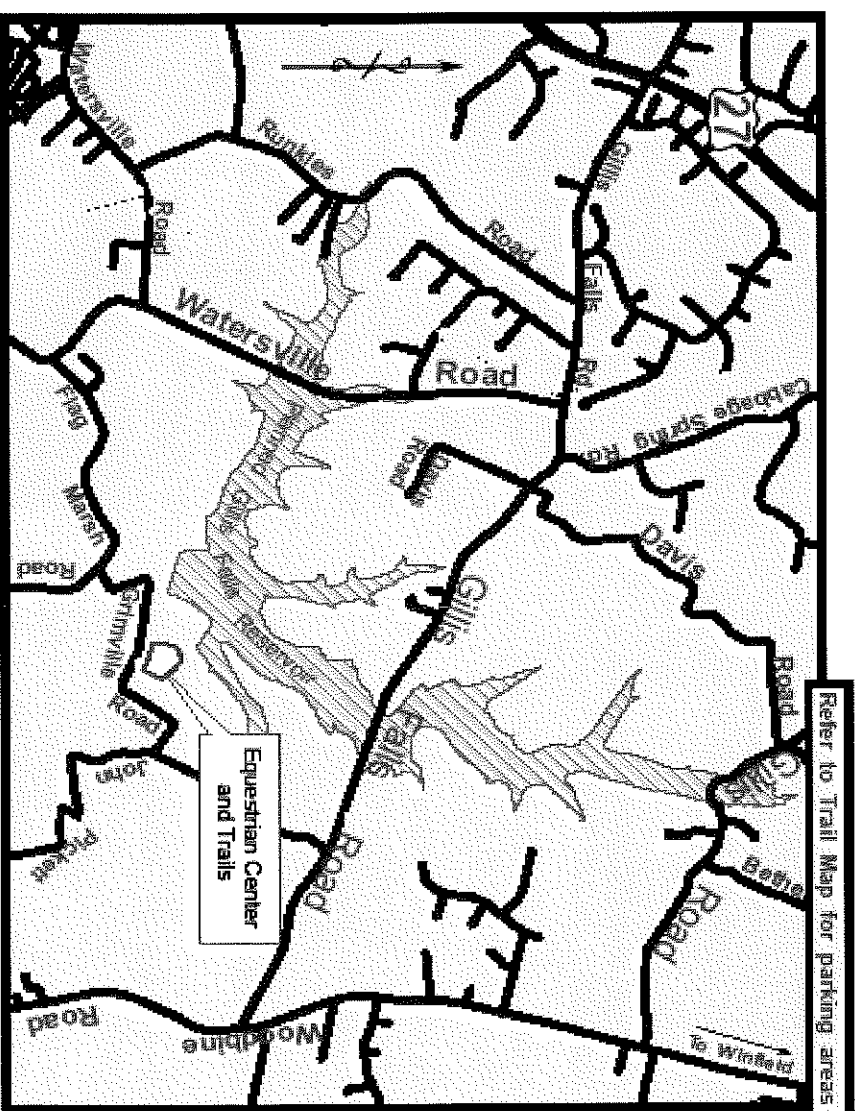

**Directions to Gills Falls Equestrian Trails & Carroll County Equestrian Center**



Refer to Trail Map for parking areas

From Rt. 70 & Rt. 27 in Mt. Airy, MD

- Travel North on Rt. 27, 2 miles to Watersville Rd.
- Turn right onto Watersville Rd.
- Travel 1.8 miles to a stop sign
- Turn right to continue on Watersville Rd.
- Travel .4 mile to Flag Marsh Rd., turn left
- Travel 1 mile to Grimville Rd.
- Turn left onto Grimville Rd.
- Travel .5 miles to Carroll County Equestrian Center

From Rt. 26 and Rt. 27 in Taylorsville, MD

- Travel South on Rt. 27, 6.25 miles to Watersville Rd.
- Turn left onto Watersville Rd.
- Travel 1.8 miles to a stop sign
- Turn right to continue on Watersville Rd.
- Travel .4 mile to Flag Marsh Rd., turn left
- Travel 1 mile to Grimville Rd.
- Turn left onto Grimville Rd.
- Travel .5 miles to Carroll County Equestrian Center

Established in 1995, the Carroll County Equestrian Center is located in the Mt. Airy area of southern Carroll County. This facility features:

**Ring #1**—Footring: Manufactured stone dust  
Size: 125 ft. X 220 ft.

**Ring #2**—Footring: Manufactured stone dust  
Size: 140 ft. X 240 ft.

The rings are located in the center of a 27 acre site with plenty of parking area. A stone entrance drive is well marked at the Grimville Road entrance. Direction signs are located on Route 27 at Watersville Road and on Route 94 at Newport Road.

### Fee Schedule:

Youth Equine Organizations (4-H, Pony Club):  
\$150/Per Day

Other Equine Organizations:  
\$225 Per Day

Instructions in the ring (by reservation)  
\$10/Per Student/Per Lesson

Instructors and students must sign a release. Reservations require a certificate of insurance for \$1,000,000 liability insurance protection.

Use of the ring for schooling purposes is free to the public, but a release form must be signed before the combination to the gate can be obtained.

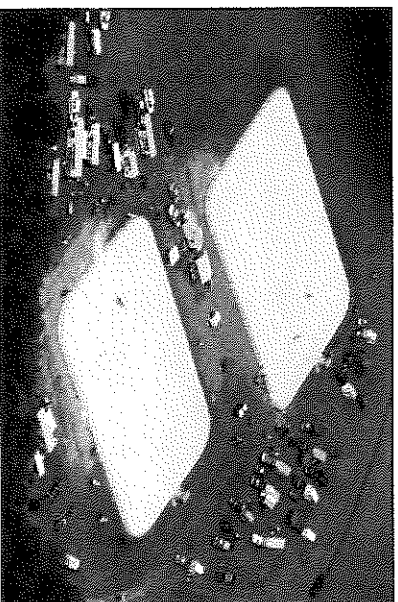

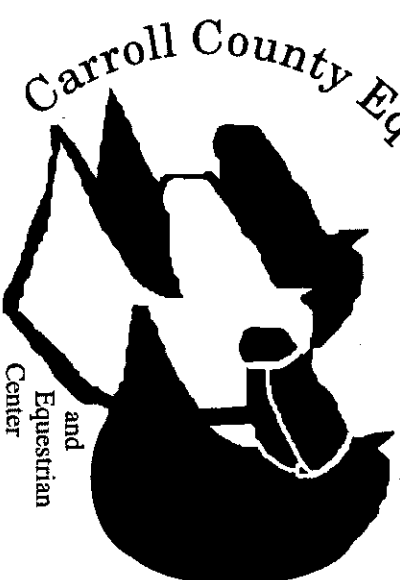
